Milestones

There are several milestones you need to complete prior to graduating:

- Successfully complete your Diagnostic Exam/Qualifying Exam at the end of your second semester.
- Have an approved Plan of Study by the start of your fourth semester.
- Pass all of the coursework required for your degree.
- Successfully complete your comprehensive exams.
- Complete your oral defense of the prospectus.
- Complete your oral defense of the dissertation.

Research Methodology

Research methodology coursework is chosen in consultation with the supervisory committee. Where appropriate, the supervisory committee may approve certification of literacy in a foreign language as meeting the research methodology requirement. This approval is granted only in those circumstances wherein fluency in that language is necessary for the dissertation research.

Continuous Enrollment

Once admitted to a graduate degree program or graduate certificate program, you must be registered for a minimum of 1 credit hour during all phases of your graduate education. Registration for every fall semester and spring semester is required. Summer registration is required for students taking examinations, completing culminating experiences, conducting a doctoral prospectus, defending theses or dissertations or graduating from the degree program.
